ORDER

1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 29.11.2022 passed by this Bench on the previous date of hearing
2. The case has been heard today. Shri Tejinder Singh comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench. He states that he has sought information regarding 15 un-authorised shops built in village Bholapur (Ludhiana) as to whether the same have been regularized or any notices for demolition have been issued to such shop owners and also the latest action taken report on the same issue. However, the information supplied by the respondent is different from what he has sought vide his RTI application. The information supplied is incorrect and misleading.
3. Shri Narinder Singh, Clerk O/o GLADA, Ludhiana comes present in person before the Bench to attend the hearing. He states that correct information has been supplied. He then requests for additional time to check the official records once again.
4. Post deliberations, the PIO is directed to reply to the appellant specifically addressing the issues raised by the appellant in his RTI application, before the next hearing.

After supplying information to the appellant, the Bench directs the PIO to file an affidavit on e-stamp paper, duly signed by the PIO and attested by the Notary Public to the effect that the information as available in the official records in AC No.1024/2021 has been supplied to the appellant. It is be further stated that nothing has been concealed therein and the statement made is true and correct. The PIO and the dealing official are also directed to come present in person before the Bench on the next hearing and also bring along the original affidavit and produce the same before the Bench.

6. With the aforesaid directions, the matter is adjourned. **To come up for hearing on 02.03.2023 at 11.30 AM before the Bench in Commission's office at Chandigarh.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
