ORDER

1. The RTI application is dated 28.05.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 27.06.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 31.08.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).

2. The case has been heard today in the Commission's office at Chandigarh. Shri Ajay Kumar, JE states that the information has been handed over to the Appellant, Shri Gurmej Lal vide letter number 1378 dated 14.10.2022 and some deficiencies were pointed out by Shri Gurmej Lal, appellant at the same time. After removing the deficiencies information has again been supplied vide letter number 1384 dated 18.10.2022 to Shri Gurmej Lal, appellant by hand. While receiving the information, Shri Gurmej Lal, appellant has shown his dissatisfaction in writing that information in relation to point number 4 and 6 is pending and the information in relation to point number 1,2,3 and 5 has been received by him. Shri Ajay Kumar, JE submits a copy of information to the bench of undersigned during the hearing, which is taken on record.

3. Shri Gurmej Lal, appellant is absent without any intimation to the Commission. He has neither come present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench nor through cisco webex nor he has deputed any representative to attend the today's hearing on his behalf.

4. Post deliberations and examination of documents on file, the Bench finds that point wise information has been provided to the appellant, Shri Gurmej Lal. As such the bench is satisfied with the information provided.

5. So, no further cause for intervention is left in this case. **This case is disposed of and closed.**
