ORDER:

1. The RTI application is dated 17.03.2020 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in her RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 16.12.2020 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 23.12.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
2. The notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 06.03.2023. Accordingly, the case has been heard today. Smt. Kamlesh, appellant comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench. The appellant states that no information has been supplied by the PIO yet.
3. Shri Gurwinder Singh, PIO comes present to attend the hearing through cisco webex. He states that the reply has been given to the appellant vide letter dated 03.03.2023 to the effect that the appellant had applied for regularization of plot under Regularisation Policy dated 18.10.2018. The case of appellant, however, was rejected. As regards refund of fee deposited by the appellant, there is no provision under the regularization policy for refund of fees once deposited. He further states that the appellant has also been informed that in future if any decision regarding refund of fee is taken by the Govt., the action for refund of amount in case of appellant will be taken up.
4. On the asking of the Bench, the PIO sends a copy of the same on WhatsApp number, the print out of which is shown to the appellant/her representative. The appellant expresses dissatisfaction on the reply and states that no reply to various letters sent in this regard has been given by the respondent earlier.
5. The Bench post deliberations observes that adequate information stands supplied to the appellant and again directs the PIO to send a copy of the same to the appellant by registered post today itself.
6. In view of the above, the Bench is not inclined to proceed further in the matter. **The instant appeal case is disposed off and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
