ORDER:

The appellant, through an RTI application dated 22.11.2021 has sought information on 07 points regarding a complaint dated 18.06.2021 filed with Police Commissioner, Amritsar UID No.2057324-a copy of the complaint – the name and designation of the officer to whom the complaint was marked – summons issued to both parties –statement of both parties –copy of enquiry report as enumerated in the RTI application from the office of Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. The appellant was not provided with the information after which the appellant filed a first appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 27.12.2021, which did not decide on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Ludhiana/Amritsar. As per the appellant, the PIO has not supplied the complete information.

The respondent present pleaded that they received the RTI application on 24.11.2022. Since, as per the report of the PC Branch, an enquiry was still pending with the enquiry officer Police containment, Amritsar, a reply was sent to the appellant vide letter dated 26.11.2022. Thereafter, the appellant filed the first appeal, which the Frist appellate Authority disposed of on 17.01.2022 since an enquiry was pending in the sought matter.

The respondent further informed that the complaint has been filed as per the current status. The Commission has also received a reply from the PIO, which has been taken on record.

Having gone through the RTI application and the reply of the PIO, the Commission finds that the RTI application has been sufficiently replied to and no further interference of the Commission is required.

The case is **disposed of and closed**.
