ORDER

1. The RTI application is dated 30.07.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 31.08.2022 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 22.12.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
2. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for hearing through CISCO WEBEX on 04.05.2023 i.e. today.
3. In today's hearing, respondent state that information was sent to the appellant and to the undersigned Bench via email on 10.04.2023. Respondent also mention that information was also sent to the appellant through registered post via letter no. IKGPTU/DA/1004 on 10.04.2023, which was returned to the respondent department with remarks 'addressee left'. It is observed that two emails dated 10.04.2023 in connection with supplied information and a reply vide diary no. 9285 dated 13.04.2023 of the Commission is received, which are taken on record.
4. Appellant is not present for today's hearing in spite of registered post notice issued to him. It is also observed that no communication is received from him after filing case in the Commission, which means he has nothing to say in this regard.
5. With aforesaid observations, no further cause of action is required in this case when appellant is not serious towards this instant appeal case. Therefore, this instant appeal case is **disposed of & closed**. Copy of the order be sent to the parties.
