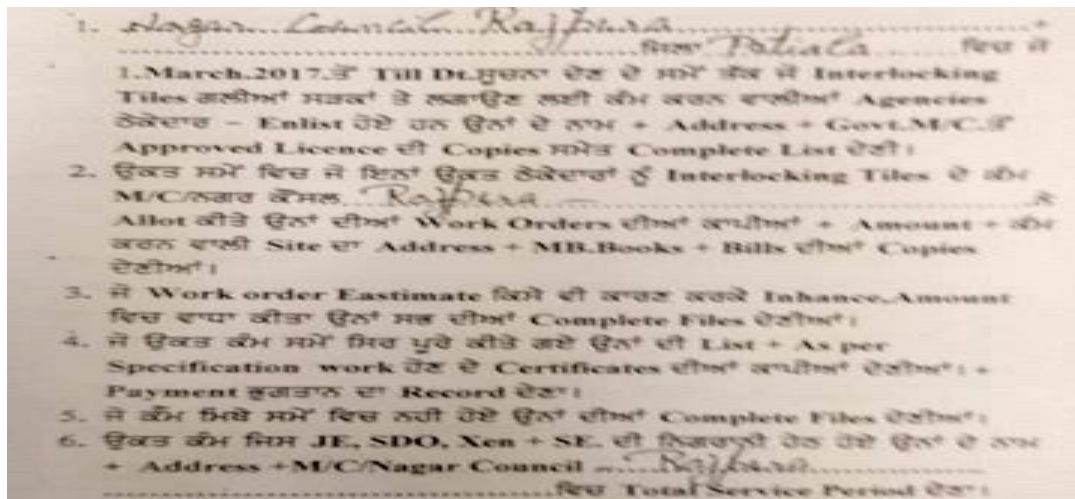

## **Appeal Case No. 1183 of 2022**

2. The appellant is absent without intimation. The respondent PIO, who was issued a Show Cause Notice, at the last hearing on 14.9.2022, has submitted a reply to said Show Cause Notice, to explain the delay in addressing this RTI application. The PIO has also submitted Letter No. 242 Dated 11.11.2022 by way of a reply to the RTI application, wherein the appellant has been informed that the requested information is “voluminous” and was requested to cite specific works. The appellant has not responded.

3. The Commission has examined the reply alongside the RTI application and concurs with the respondent PIO that the information requested in this RTI application is not specific and voluminous in nature and therefore qualifies for exemption for disclosures as per Section 7(9) of the RTI Act, 2005. This Appeal Case is accordingly **Disposed of**.
