

3. The appellant submits that the sought information has already been supplied. However, the appellant has already sent the deficiencies in the information pertaining to Point No. 2, 3 &4 which are as follows:-

- 4. After detailed deliberations with the respondent, the appellant is directed to contact Sh. Gurraj Singh, Panchayat Secretary 7837808585 along with the information supplied to get the clarification pertaining to Point No. 2 of the RTI application. With regard to Point No. 3 & 4, which are interrelated, the respondent submits that a copy of the cash book is having all the entries related to income and expenditure of the panchayat land has already been supplied from 1.1.2017 to 31.3.2021. He further submits that a copy of the same, duly certified, will again be sent to the appellant with a copy to the Commission within a week.
