## ORDER:

- 7. Both the parties are advised to represent this case in person on the next date of hearing, failing to which, appropriate order in their absence shall be passed.
- 8. With the aforesaid directions, the matter is adjourned. To come up for hearing on **04.09.2023** at **11.00** AM before the Bench in Commission's office at Chandigarh. Copies of the orders be sent to the concerned parties.
