**ORDER**

1. This order may be read with the reference to the order dated 17.11.2022 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing,
2. The case has been heard today in the Commission's office at Chandigarh. Shri Jang Bahadur, appellant has not come present to attend the hearing either in person or through cisco webex.
3. The PIO O/o DDPO, Fazilka has also not come present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench nor through cisco webex.
