ORDER:

1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 06.06.2023 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.
2. The case has been heard today. As per appellant, he has not been provided any information so far.
3. As per respondent, the RTI application of the appellant was neither legible nor specific, the appellant was asked vide letter dated 05.12.2022 and again on 18.05.2023 to visit the office of PIO on any working day and specify the information asked for but the appellant did not turn up and thus the information was not provided. Now they have collected legible copy of RTI application. The respondent further states that as per RTI application, the matter relates to recovery of enhanced payment of plots(allotted by Improvement Trust under Improvement Trust Phagwara Scheme No.1 Guru Hargobind Nagar) as per order of Hon'ble High Court on the writ petition filed by farmers whose land was acquired by Improvement Trust. Against notice of Improvement Trust for recovery of enhanced payment, some of the allottees have filed appeal before the Hon'ble District & Session Judge, Kapurthala as per C.A No.347 of 2018 which is pending for final decision. The respondent hands over the reply to the appellant during the hearing itself. The respondent also submits a copy of reply to the Bench which is taken on record.
4. Having gone through the RTI application and copy of reply received from the PIO, the Bench finds that the RTI application has been sufficiently replied to and no further interference of the Bench is needed.
5. The case is disposed off and closed. The Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
