ORDER:

1. The RTI application is dated 26.09.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 11.11.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 17.03.2023 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).

- 2. The case has been heard today. As per appellant, he has not been provided any information so far.
- 3. As per respondents, the information concerning them (relating to Division-2) has been sent to the appellant vide letter dated 06.06.2023. The respondent has also brought a copy of information along and hands over the same to the appellant during the hearing itself. The respondent further states that the information is voluminous and it involves multiple PIOs since the appellant has sought information relating to all divisions and there are 60 divisions which have their individual PIOs. Further the information has to be created which will disproportionately divert the resources of the public authority.
- 4. The Bench further observes that the information asked for by the appellant has to be collected, collated and compiled, thereby resulting in wastage of time of multiple PIOs involved. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in matter of CBSE vs. Aditya Bandopadhyay, (2011) 8 SCC 497, held as under:-
- "67. Indiscriminate and impractical demands or directions under the RTI Act for disclosure of all and sundry information (unrelated to transparency and accountability in the functioning of public authorities and eradication of corruption) would be counterproductive as it will adversely affect the efficiency of the administration and result in the executive getting bogged down with the non-productive work of collecting and furnishing information. The Act should not be allowed to be misused or abused, to become a tool to obstruct the national development and integration, or to destroy the peace, tranquility

and harmony among its citizens. Nor should it be converted into a tool of oppression or intimidation of honest officials striving to

do their duty. The nation does not want a scenario where 75% of the staff of public authorities

spends 75% of their time in collecting and furnishing information to applicants instead of discharging their

regular duties. The threat of penalties under the RTI Act and the pressure of the authorities under the

RTI Act should not lead to employees of a public authorities prioritizing "information furnishing", at the

cost of their normal and regular duties.

5. In view of the above, it does not seem to be appropriate for the appellant to seek

information which may entail engaging 75% of the employees of a public authority to collect and compile

the information for furnishing the same to the appellant. The information regarding division No.2 stands

provided. Regarding information relating to other divisions, the Bench advises the appellant to go for

seeking information by filing separate RTI application before a specific public authority who has its

separate PIO.

6. With the aforesaid observations and order, , the instant appeal case is disposed off

and closed. Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
