## ORDER :

#### Facts emerging during the hearing:

- This order may be read with the reference of previous hearing of the Commission dated 31.08.2022 vide which " the appellant was absent and the Commission granted a last & final opportunity to the appellant to represent this case on next date of hearing falling to which the case will be decided on merits".
- 2. Repeated opportunities were given to the appellant to appear and to represent his case before the Commission. However, the appellant preferred to remain absent continuously during the last three hearings i.e. 28.03.2022, 18.04.2022, 31.08.2022 and even today i.e. 19.10.2022.

# **Observations and Decision :**

3. The essence of the matter is that opportunity to be heard has been given to the appellant but has not been availed of. If the requirement of hearing is to be deemed to be fulfilled by giving the appellant who is present an opportunity to be heard it should be regarded as equally fulfilled even in the case of an appellant who has chosen to be absent in spite of having been given an opportunity to be heard.
