- 1. This order may be read with the reference of previous order of the Commission dated 10.01.2023.
- 2. Respondent, Sh. Simranjeet Singh stated that Information pertaining to point no. 1 of this appeal case is not available at this office. The office Nagar Panchayat, Gharun has come into existence on 10-12-2021. Earlier, the process of granting CU to colonies and commercial plots/sun-rooms in this area was done by GAMADA. The record of which is not available in this office and no action has been taken by this office from the date of notification of the Nagar Panchayat to the date of filing the said RTI. For point no. 2 he added that this information does not come under the RTI Act as it is questionable, but still it is stated that no notice and legal action has been taken in this regard since the coming into existence of the office of Nagar Panchayat Gharun till the date of filing the said RTI.
- 3. Keeping in view the facts of the case and after going through the submissions made by the respondent PIO, the Commission finds that the RTI application has been suitably replied and the information has been supplied to the best extent. Moreover, the factual position has been brought to the notice of the appellant by the respondent for further query, if any.

Therefore, no cause of action is required in this case. Hence, the instant appeal case is **disposed & closed.**
