- 6. Appellant is advised to go through the information, once he had received and point out discrepancy within seven days in writing to the respondent PIO with a copy to the Commission, failing which it will be presumed that he has nothing to say in this regard.
- 7. Both the parties are advised to represent this case in person on the next date of hearing, failing to which, appropriate order in their absence shall be passed.
- 8. With the aforesaid directions, the matter is adjourned. To come up for hearing on 04.09.2023 at 11.00 AM before the Bench in Commission's office at Chandigarh. Copies of the orders be sent to the concerned parties.
