ORDER:

The appellant, through an RTI application dated 11.02.2022 has sought information regarding the status of complaint Number UID-199635 dated 24.03.2021 against Sh.Baljeet Singh s/o Sh.Gurdev Singh to SSP Amritsar as enumerated in the RTI application from the office of Deputy Commissioner of Police Amritsar City. The appellant was not provided with the information, after which the appellant filed a first appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 05.03.2022, which did not decide on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Amritsar. The appellant claims that the PIO has not supplied the information.

The respondent present pleaded that since an ID proof was not attached by the appellant alongwith the RTI application, the appellant was asked to vide letter dated 21.02.2022 to send ID proof, which the appellant did not provide, and filed the first appeal on 05.03.2022.

As per the respondent, when a report was taken from the concerned branch, it was reported that the provided UID number was incorrect, and the appellant was informed of the same. Once the appellant sent the correct UID No.1999635 on 21.04.2022, a report was called from the concerned branch, and the reply was sent to the appellant vide letter dated 12.05.2022 that since the investigation was pending with Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police Amritsar City-2, the information cannot be provided.

As per the appellant, the ADC has already submitted the enquiry report.

As per the respondent, on the date of the filing of the RTI application, the investigation was still pending.

Since the investigation was pending on the filing of the RTI application, the RTI application has been sufficiently replied to. If the appellant wants the latest complaint status, the appellant is advised to file a fresh RTI application.

The case is **disposed of and closed.**
