ORDER:

The appellant, through an RTI application dated 14.03.2022, has sought information on 14 points regarding the name and address of the protection officer who conducted the domestic incident enquiry in case No.194 – a copy of the order of Hon'ble Magistrate to protection officer – a copy of the enquiry report on the enquiry if any conducted before filing DIR – a copy of enquiry report if any after filing DIR – a copy of statements of parties etc. as enumerated in the RTI application from the office of Child Development and Project Officer, Amritsar. The appellant was not provided with the information after which the appellant filed a first appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 19.04.2022, which did not decide on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Amritsar. The respondent present pleaded that the information available in the record has been provided to the appellant and no further information is available in the record. The respondent has also sent a copy of the information to the Commission, which has been taken on record.

The appellant claims that the information supplied by the PIO is incomplete.

Having gone through the RTI application, copy of the information received from the PIO and hearing both the parties, the Commission finds that the RTI application has been sufficiently replied to and the information has been provided to the best possible extent.

No further interference of the Commission is required. The case is **disposed of and closed.**
