**ORDER:**

1. The RTI application is dated 01.12.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 05.01.2023 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 05.04.2023 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
2. The case has been heard today. As per respondent, the matter relates to a complaint filed by the appellant on 06.12.2021 for regularisation of three hundred unauthorised colonies constructed in the jurisdiction of Zone-C, MC Ludhiana, the complaint was sent to M.C. Ludhiana for enquiry vide letter dated 04.02.2022 but still no report has been received from them so far. The reply alongwith relevant noting and correspondence has been sent to the appellant vide letter dated 20.06.2023 through registered post. The respondent also submits a copy of letter to the Bench which is taken on record.
3. The appellant has not come present either in person or through cisco-webex.
4. Having gone through the RTI application and reply of the PIO, the Bench finds that the RTI application has been sufficiently replied to and no further interference of the Bench is needed. A copy of reply received from the PIO be sent to the appellant along with the order also.
5. The case is **disposed off and closed**. Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
