ORDER:

The appellant, through an RTI application dated 28.12.2021 has sought information regarding action taken on the complaint dated 15.11.2021 filed against Dy. Medical Suptd. Narinder Singh for doing illegal practice alongwith name and mobile number of the inspecting officer as enumerated in the RTI application from the office of Director Health and Family Affairs, Pb Chandigarh. The appellant was not provided the information after which the appellant filed a first appeal before the First Appellate Authority on 09.02.2022, which did not decide on the appeal.

The case has come up for hearing today through video conferencing at DAC Ludhiana. Both the parties are absent.

From the record, the Commission observes that the appellant has also filed similar appeal case No.2271 of 2022 and 2273 of 2022 for seeking precisely the same information from the office of Civil Surgeon, Amritsar and from the office of Principal Secretary, Health & Family Welfare, Pb Chandigarh respectively.

In the appeal case No.2271 of 2022, the PIO O/o Civil Surgeon, Amritsar vide email has informed that the matter relates to the Director Principal Govt. Medical College, Amritsar and the they have sent the complaint to them vide letter dated 28.01.2022.

In appeal case No.2273 of 2022, the respondent present pleaded that the enquiry was conducted by the Director Principal, Govt. Medical College, Amritsar on the complaint of the appellant as well as the exactly the same complaints by some other complainants.

According to the respondent, they have sent the enquiry report, a copy of which is submitted to the Commission.

The appellant is absent nor is represented.

A copy of the enquiry report submitted by the respondent in appeal case No.2273 of 2022 is being sent to the appellant alongwith the order. This takes care of information for all the cases mentioned above.

With the above, the information stands provided. No further interference of the Commission is required. The case is **disposed of and closed**.
