**ORDER:**

1. The RTI application is dated 05.01.2023 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 04.03.2023 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 10.04.2023 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
2. The case has been heard today. As per respondent, the appellant had sought action taken report on his complaint UID No.2294211 dated 06.04.2022 and complaint No.11973-CD-1 dated 06.04.2022. As per report of Police Station (Women-2), Amritsar, the enquiry was pending on the date of filing of RTI application and thus the information was not provided under section 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act and reply to this effect was sent to the appellant vide letter dated 16.02.2023. Now as per report of Police Station (Women-2) Amritsar, after completion of enquiry, challan has been filed in the court of Smt.Harpreet Kaur, JMIC Amritsar and the appellant may seek the information from the Hon'ble court. The Commission has also received reply of the PIO on 26.06.2023 which is taken on record.
3. The appellant is absent nor is represented.
4. Having gone through the RTI application and copy of reply received from the PIO, the Bench finds that the RTI application has been sufficiently replied to and no further interference of the Bench is needed.
5. The case is **disposed off and closed**. Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
