## **Appeal Case No. 2568 of 2022**

ORDER:

*(To be read in continuity with earlier orders on **12.7.2022 and 23.8.2022**)*

1. The RTI application is dated **29.12.2021** vide which the appellant has sought information **regarding two applications to the Superintendent House Tax Zone A by the appellant and her relative Sandeep Kumar**, as enumerated in her RTI application. First Appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (FAA) on **9.2.2022** and Second Appeal was filed in the Commission on **26.5.2022** under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005. The case was last heard on **23.8.2022**.

2. Both parties are present. The respondent PIO has submitted a reply to the Show Cause Notice issued to him vide this Commission's Order of 12.7.2022, wherein he has appended copies of two separate replies sent to the appellant vide Letter No. 289 Dated 9.9.2022 and No. 270 Dated 6.9.2022, both with pointwise replies to the RTI application. As per deficiencies listed by the appellant in an email Dated 14.10.2022, a third reply was sent vide Letter No 309 on 21.9.2022, along with some additional information. The appellant however, states that the supplied information is still deficient and has listed said deficiencies in her email of 14.10.2022. The appellant states that she has communicated the deficiencies via WhatsApp to the respondent PIO. She is however, requested to also communicate the aforesaid deficiency in a letter to the respondent PIO.

3. The respondent PIO is hereby directed to submit a written pointwise reply to the appellant by way of a duly notarized affidavit. This must be done before the next hearing.
