**ORDER**

1. This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 26.10.2022 vide which respondent stated that information is voluminous and sensitive in nature. Respondent PIO was directed to supply the information for the year 2021 and an inspection was fixed for Monday i.e. 31.10.2022 at 12.00 noon.

The respondent was also directed to supply the information as per RTI application upto 100 pages free of cost and thereafter get the necessary fee deposited against the excess pages. The case was adjourned to 7.12.2022.

2. In today's hearing both the parties are present.
3. The respondent, Sh. Anshul Khullar states that information was handed over to the appellant by hand on 10.11.2022 and no discrepancy has been pointed out by him till yet.
4. Appellant, Sh. Ajay Sharma intimates the Commission telephonically that he has received information from the respondent but not readable.
5. After hearing both the parties and examining the case file, it is observed that sufficient time has elapsed from the receiving of information but deficiency has not been pointed out by the appellant, which is a sheer wastage of precious time and resources of the Commission as it also affects the disposal of the case.

Appellant is advised to point out ambiguity in writing to the respondent PIO with a copy to the Commission by Monday i.e. 12.12.2022, failing which case will be decided on merit basis.

6. Respondent PIO is directed to remove discrepancy within ten days after the receipt of this order along with directions to represent this case on the next date of hearing
