ORDER

- 1. The RTI application dated 11.3.2023 vide which the complainant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. A complaint is filed in the Commission on 3.5.2023 under Section 18 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for hearing for 6.6.2023 through CISCO WEBEX application.
- 2. In today's hearing both the parties are present.
- 3. The complainant states that he filed RTI application dated 11.03.2023 but no response from the respondent PIO.
- 4. The respondent Sh. Rupinder Garg, Advocate states that the Bar Association does not cover under RTI Act, 2005. He further adds that the Bar Association is not established or constituted by any Act or Legislature of the Parliament or by any law of the State Legislature. Moreover, the Bar Association is not at all financed or controlled by the appropriate Govt. in any manner since the time of its incorporation. He adds that an email dated 04.06.2023 has also been sent to the undersigned Bench in this regard, which is received and taken on record.
- 5. After hearing both the parties, it is brought to the notice of both the parties that Central Information Commission has ruled that Bar Association are constituted under a law made by Parliament, i.e., the Advocate Act, 1961 and hence they come under the purview of the RTI Act.
- 6. As per decision of the Central Information Commission passed on 17.03.2016 in the following cases:

The bar council is a statutory body constituted under Advocates Act, 1961 to protect ethical standards of advocates and admonish the members for misconduct. The information about this core function of Bar Council cannot be denied to the appellant as it does not attract any exemption under RTI Act.
