## **ORDER**

- 1. The RTI application is dated 02.05.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 08.06.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 23.08.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
- 2. The notice for hearing was issued to the parties for 11.10.2022. Accordingly, the case has been heard today in the Commission's office at Chandigarh. Shri Manjit Singh, Appellant has not come present to attend the hearing either in person or through cisco webex.
- 3. Shri Manjit Singh, Superintendent, O/o D.C. Ferozepur comes present to attend the hearing through cisco webex and states that the complaint made by the appellant is under investigation with Civil Surgeon, Fazilka and thus, his complaint has not been disposed off yet. He further states that reply to this effect has been sent vide letter dated 06.10.2022 to the appellant.
- 4. Shri Manjit Singh, appellant is contacted on mobile phone. He states that due to some family problem, he has not been able to attend the hearing. Then he is apprised of the version of the representative of PIO and the letter dated 06.10.2022 sent to him, receipt of which he denies. He is clarified that the investigation into his complaint is pending and the related documents have been supplied to him by the PIO. The Bench does not feel need for further intervention in the matter.
- 5. In view of the above, no cause for further action in the matter is called for. **As such, the instant appeal case is disposed off and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
