(To be read in continuity with earlier orders on **24.8.2021, 26.10.2021, 3.3.2022, and 23.6.2022**)

1. The RTI application is dated 16.11.2020 vide which the appellant has sought information:

Sh. Jaswant Singh's family made dedicated efforts to resolve the issue, but Sub Gurnel Singh not heeded to. Some eminent persons of surrounding villages and close relatives also sustained efforts to resolve the issue. After so many blame-games by both the parties, mentioned "Transfer of Ownership Mutations" executed till date to resolve the issue :-
