ORDER

1. This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 22.09.2022 vide which respondent Sh. Sumit Kumar (Clerk) stated that information was sent to the appellant via an email dated 19.09.2022 but representative of the appellant denied on the same. Accordingly, respondent PIO was directed to send information once again within 2 days, via an email at her mailing address: Australia110001@gmail.com (given by the representative of the appellant during the hearing).

Appellant was advised to go through the information once she received email in this regard and point out ambiguity, if any, in writing as per RTI application, to the respondent PIO with a copy to the Commission, failing which case will be decided on merit basis. Matter was adjourned for further hearing on 29.11.2022.

2. In today's hearing, representative of the appellant states that information is not received from the respondent PIO.
3. After examining the documents placed on record, it is observed that an email dated 26.09.2022 is received from the appellant from her email ID australia110001@gmail.com comprising a letter regarding discrepancies in the supplied information. In that reply she has pointed out point-wise discrepancy.
4. Respondent PIO is absent in spite of registered post order issued to him by the Commission. A copy of this order along with discrepancy letter (received from appellant via email 26.09.2022) be sent to him by name through registered post for his ready reference. He is directed to remove the discrepancy as per RTI application within ten days after receipt of this order.
