## <u>ORDER</u>

1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 06.10.2022 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.

2. The case has been heard today in the Commission's office at Chandigarh. Shri Tejinder Singh, appellant attends the hearing through cisco webex.

3. Shri Bhupinder Singh, Senior Assistant also attends the hearing through ciso webex and states that information has been supplied to the Appellant, Shri Tejinder Singh vide letter dated 04.10.2022. He further states that the information sought in this appeal case and in Appeal Case No.3038/2022 is the same.

3. On the asking of this bench, the Appellant, Shri Tejinder Singh states that he has received the information. He, however, contends the version of the PIO that no record regarding survey of the illegal constructions and illegal colonies by GLADA is available and further states that in another Appeal Case No.1177/2022, the PIO had stated the no such survey was got conducted after 2018.

4. Post deliberation, the representative of PIO clarifies to Shri Tejinder Singh that the record relating to such colonies is available on the website of GLADA upto 2018 and no survey has been conducted by GLADA after 2018 and thus, the information related to illegal colonies after 2018 cannot be supplied.

5. Post deliberations and hearing the version of appellant and the respondent, the Bench is convinced that requisite information stands supplied to the appellant.

6. In view of the above, the Bench does not feel need for further intervention in the matter. The instant appeal case is disposed off and closed. Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
