### **ORDER:**

1. The RTI application is dated **28.12.2021** vide which the appellant has sought information **regarding fire safety/NOCs issued to the hospitals**, as enumerated in his RTI application. First Appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (FAA) on **9.2.2022** and Second Appeal was filed in the Commission on **27.6.2022** under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005. Notice was issued to the parties for first hearing in the Commission on **20.10.2022**.

2. Both parties are present. The respondent PIO, represented by Sh. Kartar Singh, Fire Station Officer and Ricky Walia, Clerk, have submitted copy of pointwise reply sent to the appellant vide Letter No. 763 Dated 21.9.2022, wherein the appellant was invited to inspect the record with respect to point no. 1 and 3 of the RTI application while he has been informed that no action has been taken by the department as sought in point no. 2 and 4 of the RTI application.

3. After deliberations at this hearing, the Commission directs the respondent PIO to arrange for the appellant to inspect the record at 11.00 am on 31.10.2022, following which up to 100 pages requested by the appellant are to be provided free of cost after due attestation. Any additional copies to be paid for by the appellant at the normal rate of photocopying. Alternatively, the appellant has offered to carry a pen-drive and if the record sought by him is available in electronic format, this is to be provided to him on the pen-drive at no extra cost.
