**ORDER:**

1. This case may be read to the reference of the previous order dated 19.01.2023.
2. In today's hearing, the appellant, Sh. Manjinder Singh states that incomplete information has been supplied to him and further requests for inspection of record in relation to Traffic Police Challans of vehicles held on dated 05.04.2018.
3. On the other hand, the Senior Assistant, Sh. Arvinder Singh verbally explains the facts about this case and the show cause notice which was issued to the PIO concerned is dropped. During the hearing, he further submits the letter number 455 dated 20.03.2022 and letter dated 05.01.2023, which are taken on record. He further mentions that a reply vide letter number 407 dated 14.03.2023 (along with annexure), which has been sent to the Commission (vide diary no. 7299 dated 20.03.2022) is received and taken on record.
4. After going through case file and discussing it with present parties, the Senior Assistant, Sh. Arvinder Singh is directed to look into this matter again and he is directed to show the record of challans for dated 05.04.2018 to the appellant at the time of inspection of visit dated 10.04.2023 (Monday at 11.00 a.m.) and if the information is not available with them then the PIO is directed to file an affidavit as per queries raised in the RTI application dated 15.03.2021 to the appellant (in original) within 15 days from today, with a copy to the Commission through email / post.
5. The concerned PIO or other concerned officials are directed to be there at the time of inspection on the said date and time on the Appellant's visit.
6. With the aforesaid directions, this case is **disposed off and closed**. Copy of the order be sent to the parties.
