He refers to his submissions produced before the Bench stating that the PIO has failed to supply information on points No.1,5,6,7,15,16, 17 & 18 and pen drive containing videos and 27photos has also not been provided in spite of his visit on 20.12.2022 as per orders of Hon'ble Commission. He also contents that PIO is the SSP Sangrur and the SHOs of Police Stations under his control are the APIOs and information/CCTV footage etc. needs to be collected form the APIOs concerned and supplied to the appellant.
