**ORDER:**

1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 11.01.2023 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.
2. The case has been heard today. Shri Jiwan Garg, appellant comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench. He submits before the Bench his written submissions dated 06.02.2023 and also hands over copy to the respondents.
3. Shri Manpreet Singh, S.P., with ASI Kuldeep Singh and Smt. Rupinder Kaur, Senior Assistant O/o SSP Sangrur, on behalf of PIO/Respondent come present in person before the Bench. Shri Manpreet Singh, SP states that out of 19 points of RTI application, the appellant has been supplied information on 14 points and for information on remaining points, the appellant was called on 20.12.2022 and allowed access to all relevant records. He has been provided point wise information as available in the official records.
4. On the asking of the Bench, the appellant admits receipt of certain information after his visit to the office of SSP Sangrur. He refers to his submissions produced before the Bench stating that the PIO has failed to supply information on points No.1,5,6,7,15,16, 17 & 18 and pen drive containing videos and 27 photos has also not been provided in spite of his visit on 20.12.2022 as per orders of Hon'ble Commission. He also contents that PIO is the SSP Sangrur and the SHOs of Police Stations under his control are the APIOs and information/CCTV footage etc. needs to be collected from the APIOs concerned and supplied to the appellant.

5. The respondent states that appellant has been allowed access to relevant records during his visit on 20.12.2022 and the pen drive as also the original records have been brought along. On the asking of the Bench, the respondent hands over the pen drive to the appellant in the court itself. The appellant requests for time to go through its contents.

6. Post deliberations, the Bench directs the PIO O/o SSP Sangrur to afford another opportunity to the appellant to inspect the relevant records and the information as is identified by the appellant be provided to him, duly attested by the PIO. The PIO is also directed to come present in person before the Bench on the next hearing.

7. The appellant is advised to also come present in person before the Bench on the next date of hearing.

8. With the aforesaid directions, the matter is adjourned. **To come up for hearing on 03.04.2023 at 11.30 AM in Commission's office at Chandigarh.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
