ORDER:

1. The RTI application is dated 16.06.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 27.07.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 03.01.2023 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
2. Shri Gurfateh Singh, Advocate, representative of the appellant states that he has received the information today before entering the Court room and he mentions that incomplete information in relation to point number 1, 4 and 6 of the RTI application has been supplied to him.
3. Shri Guljar Singh, Divisional Superintendent submits a copy of information to the Commission vide letter number 1322 dated 23.02.2023 during the hearing, which is seen and taken on record. He further mentions that the information as available in their official records has been supplied to the appellant and nothing beyond what has been provided is available in official records.
4. Post deliberations, the Bench directs the PIO to file an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper, within 21 days, duly signed by the PIO and attested by the Notary Public to the effect that the information as available in official records has been supplied to the appellant vide letter dated 23.02.2023 in AC: 321 / 2023. It is further stated that nothing has been concealed therein and the information supplied to the Appellant is true and correct. The original affidavit be sent to the Appellant and the copy of the same be sent to the Bench for record. The representative of the appellant, Advocate, Shri Gurfateh Singh gives his consent to close the case.
5. With the aforesaid directions. **This case is disposed off and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
