**ORDER:**

1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 14.03.2023 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.
2. The case has been heard today. The appellant is absent. The appellant is contacted on his mobile, he states that information has not been supplied.

As per respondents, in compliance with the order of the Commission, the appellant was asked vide letter dated 03.04.2023 to inspect the record by visiting the office of the PIO on 06.04.2023 but the appellant did not turn up. However, point-wise information as available in the official record based on the issues raised by the appellant in the RTI application has been sent to the appellant vide letter dated 10.04.2023 through registered post. The respondent has also brought a copy of the information along for handing over to the appellant during the hearing itself.
