ORDER

1. This case may be read with the reference to the order dated 20.10.2022 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.
2. The case has been heard today. Shri Manmohan Upneja, representative of the appellant comes in person before the Bench and states that deficiencies pointed out have not been removed and rectified information is still awaited.
3. Shri Diamond, Clerk O/o Tehsildar, Fazilka comes present to attend the hearing through cisco webex on behalf of the PIO. He states that the record relating to Notary Register is not available in their office. He further states that according to the appellant, it may be with the D.C. Office, but he affirms that it is not available in office of Tehsildar and that no such record regarding deposit of Notary Public register is available in their office. He states that the information as per official records stands supplied to the appellant vide letter dated 14.09.2022.
4. Post deliberations, the Bench directs the PIO to again send a copy of the information and file an affidavit on e-stamp paper, within 21 (Twenty one) days, duly signed by the PIO and attested by the Notary Public to the effect that the information as available in the official records in AC No.3441/2022 has been supplied to the appellant. It be further stated that no Rule/Regulations regarding the misuse of Notary Register or deposit of Notary Register in case of death of Notary Public, are available in their official records and no such record is being maintained in the office of Tehsildar, Fazilka. It be further stated that nothing has been concealed therein and the statement made is true and correct. Original affidavit be sent to the appellant and copy of the same be sent to the Commission for record.
5. With the aforesaid directions, **the instant appeal case is disposed off and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
