**Present:** Appellant: Sh. Vijay Singh at PSIC office.

ORDER:

- The RTI application is dated 03.06.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 22.08.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 04.01.2023 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act) and the hearing has been fixed for today.
- 2. In today's hearing, the appellant, Shri Vijay Singh states that irrelevant record has been supplied to him on 25.07.2022.
- 3. The respondent is absent without any intimation to the undersigned bench. Commission takes a serious view of the casual approach of the Respondent / PIO, in spite of issuing of registered post notice of hearing but still nobody appears from the department today to represent this case.
- 4. In view of the foregoing, respondent PIO, O/o The Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat, Bathlana, Tehsil and District Mohali is directed to Show Cause in writing or through affidavit under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act, as to why penalty should not be imposed upon him for wilful delay / denial of the information to the RTI applicant and why the compensation be not awarded to the appellant under Section 19 (8)(b) of the Act for detriment suffered.

In addition to his submission, the PIO is also hereby given an opportunity under Section 20(1) proviso, thereto, for a personal hearing before the imposition of such penalty on the next date of hearing. He may note that in case he does not file his submission and does not avail himself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the next date fixed, it will be presumed that he has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceedings against him ex-parte.

through registered post for the compliance of this order and to look into the matter as RTI

the next date of hearing to clear the facts of this case, failing which the case will be decided

on merits.
