ORDER:

1. This case may be read with the reference to the previous order dated 25.01.2023.

2. In today's hearing, appellant states that information is still pending from the respondent PIO

even after issuing directions on 03.11.2022 and 25.01.2023.

3. Respondent PIO is continuously absent third time without any intimation to the Commission.

He was also absent on previous hearings held on 03.11.2022 and 25.01.2023, which means he

has no regard to the notices and orders issued to him by the Commission.

4. RTI Act, 2005 came into existence in order to promote transparency and accountability in the

working of every public authority, not to harass public to collect information

5. From the material on record, it transpires that there has been unnecessary delay in conveying

the correct State of affairs to the appellant in respect to his request for information. No

explanation for delay has been given by him. Rather, his failure to even respond to the

directions issued to him by the Commission reinforces the fact that he has been without any

reasonable cause guilty of remissness in the discharge of his duties, therefore, deserves to be

penalized.

6. In view of the defying attitude of the concerned respondent PIO, Regional Transport Authority,

Farikot neither attending the court nor submitting any explanation for the directions issued to

him within the time schedule as prescribed under the RTI Act 2005, the court comes to a logical

conclusion that it is a fit case for the imposition of penalty amounting to Rs. 10000/- (Rupees

Ten thousand only) upon the concerned respondent PIO. However, taking a lenient view, I

impose a penalty of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand only) on the respondent PIO. The Drawing

and Disbursing Officer of the office of RTA, Faridkot is directed to deduct the amount of penalty

of Rs. 10000/- from the salary of the concerned respondent PIO and be deposited in the State

Treasury in the following Head of Account and to report its compliance to the Commission:-

800-Other Receipts

86-Fee under the RTI Act, 2005

7. A copy of this order be sent to the First Appellate Authority by name through registered post

to look into the matter on priority basis as appellant filed RTI application on 09.05.2022 and still

waiting for collecting the requisite information, which indeed is a serious matter.
