ORDER

1. This order may be read with the reference to the previous order dated 17.10.2022.
2. The case has been heard today in the Commission's office at Chandigarh. Shri Jagtar Singh, Appellant states that no information has been supplied to him.
3. Shri Rajinder Kumar, Panchayat Secretary states that he has brought the information in the Court. He further submits a letter dated 11.11.2022 to the Bench, which is taken on record.
3. The Bench directs the representative of PIO and the appellant to sit together in the adjacent court room and the representative of PIO is directed to explain the position on each point of RTI application to the appellant and thereafter, appear again before the Bench.
4. Thereafter, both the appellant and respondent appear before the Bench and the appellant still expresses his dissatisfaction as the information which has been supplied to him is not attested. The documents have been given back to Shri Rajinder Kumar, Panchayat Secretary for attestation and further directed to supply the documents to the appellant duly attested within next two days.
5. Post deliberations, the Bench also directs the PIO to file an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper, within 21 days, duly signed by the PIO and attested by the Notary Public to the effect that the information as available in official records has been supplied to the appellant in AC: 3615 / 2021. It be further stated that nothing has been concealed therein and the information supplied to the Appellant is true and correct. The original affidavit must be sent to the Appellant and the copy of the same be sent to the bench of undersigned.
6. With the aforesaid directions, the instant appeal case is **disposed off and closed**. Copies of the order be sent to the parties.
