**ORDER**

1. The RTI application is dated 14.5.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 25.6.2022 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 5.8.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for hearing through CISCO WEBEX on 9.11.2022 and further postponed to 9.2.2023 at 11.00 a.m.
2. In today's hearing, both the parties are present.
3. The appellant states that nothing has been received with regard to his RTI application till date. He further pleads that suitable direction be given so that he may get the information.
4. The respondent, Ms. Kulwinder Kaur states that information was sent to the appellant via an email on 1.11.2022, which the appellant contests stating nothing has been received till date. She adds that email dated 01.11.2022 was also sent to the undersigned Bench, which is received and taken on record.
5. After discussing with both the parties in detail, respondent PIO is directed to supply the requisite information as per RTI application to the appellant within seven days from today. Appellant is advised to go through the information, once he had received and point out discrepancy within seven days in writing to the respondent PIO with a copy to the Commission, failing which it will be presumed that he has nothing to say in this regard.
6. With the aforesaid directions, this instant appeal case is **disposed of & closed**. Announced in the Court. Copies of this order be sent to the parties.
