**ORDER:**

1. The RTI application is dated 20.04.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 13.06.2022 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 09.08.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).
2. Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for hearing through CISCO WEBEX on 15.11.2022 i.e. today.
3. In today's hearing, appellant states that information in connection with point numbers 4, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 14 and 16 is still pending from the respondent PIO.
4. On this respondent, Sh. Gurmeet Singh states that information as available in the official record had already been supplied to the appellant comprising 171 pages. He adds that appellant was called for inspection, in case he is not satisfied with the supplied information. It is also observed that a letter no. 158 dated 07.11.2022 is received from the respondent in the Commission vide diary no. 25766 dated 10.11.2022, which is considered and taken on record.
5. After having detailed discussion with both the parties, both the parties mutually agreed that the applicant shall visit the office of respondent on 18.11.2022 at 12:00 Noon, inspect the relevant records and identify the documents copies whereof are required by him in connection with point numbers 4, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 14 and 16 of the RTI application; and the respondent shall provided copies thereof, according to his RTI application within a fortnight, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the RTI Act, 2005.
6. Both the parties are advised to represent this case on the next date of hearing positively, failing which case will be decided on merit basis.
7. To come up on **08.02.2023 at 11:00 A.M. through CISCO-Webex** (Video Conferencing application). Copy of the order be sent to the parties.
