ORDER:

1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 14.03.2023 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.
2. The case has been heard today. As per representative of the appellant, the PIO has not supplied information yet.
3. As per respondents, the appellant visited their office on 03.04.2023 and inspected the record and identified the documents. The appellant was asked to deposit requisite fee of Rs.8066/- for the documents as identified by him and get the information. A letter to this effect has also been issued on 06.04.2023. The respondent has also sent letter to the representative of the appellant on his whatsapp. The respondents further state that some of the record could not be produced before the appellant since the same is lying with vigilance bureau in connection with an investigation.
4. The Bench concurs with the submission of the PIO. The appellant is directed to deposit the requisite fee as raised by the PIO vide letter dated 06.04.2023 and get the relevant information/documents as identified except the record which is lying with vigilance bureau. The PIO is directed to provide information to the appellant as identified once the fee is deposited.
5. The representative of the appellant has requested for some additional time to scrutinize the documents which is granted.
6. The case is adjourned. **To come up for hearing on 31.05.2023 at 11.30 AM before the Bench in Commission's office at Chandigarh.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
