ORDER

The RTI application is dated 18.5.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter called FAA) on 24.6.2022 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 24.8.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter called RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 3.10.2022 but the case could not be heard on the said date and further adjourned for today i.e. 4.10.2022 and the parties were informed telephonically.

2. The appellant has sought the following information as per his RTI application:-

”ਸ਼੍ਰੀਮਾਨਜੀ ਮੇਰੇ ਵੱਲੋਂ ਰਜਿਸਟਰਡ ਡਾਕ ਦੁਆਰਾ ਇੱਕ ਸਿਕਾਇਤ ਮਿੱਤੀ 5/3/2022 ਅਤੇ ਮਿੱਤੀ 15/4/2022 ਨੂੰ ਆਪਜੀ ਨੂੰ ਭੇਜੀ ਗਈ ਸੀ। ਮੇਰੀ ਉਕਤ ਸਿਕਾਇਤ ਤੇ ਆਪਜੀ ਵੱਲੋਂ ਜਾਂ ਸਬੰਧਿਤ ਅਧਿਕਾਰੀ ਵੱਲੋਂ ਕੀਤੀ ਗਈ ਮੁਕੰਮਲ ਕਾਰਵਾਈ ਤੇ ਦਫਤਰੀ ਨੋਟਿੰਗ ਦੀ ਤਸਦੀਕ ਸੁਦਾਕਾ ਪੀ ਦਿੱਤੀ ਜਾਵੇ।”

3. The appellant is absent but he has sent the written submissions, which are taken on record.

4. However, the respondent submits that the similar information has already been supplied to the appellant in another case i.e. Appeal Case No. 3754 of 2022. He has also submitted the information supplied to the appellant in the said case, which is taken on record. A copy of the same is again **being sent** to the appellant along with this order.

5. After the perusal of the record and the submissions made by the parties, the Commission is of the view that no further action is required to be taken in this case as the appellant has sought the similar information in two cases. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed.
