ORDER:

1. The RTI application is dated 20.09.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 31.10.2022 the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 05.01.2023 Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act) and the hearing has been fixed for today.
2. In today's hearing, the appellant, Sh. Manjinder Singh states that no information has been supplied to him.
3. The respondent PIO is absent without any intimation to the Commission.
4. Commission takes a serious view of the casual approach of the Respondent / PIO, as Respondent PIO is absent in spite of registered post notice issued to him by the Commission, which shows PIO's casual attitude towards the directions of the Commission. The absence of the PIO is viewed seriously and it has also affected hearing and disposal of the case. In pursuance of this, the PIO is directed to file a written submission in response to the Notice of the Commission and should present this case personally (through cisco webex), on the next date of hearing, failing which penal consequences shall follow.
5. In view of the foregoing, **respondent PIO, O/o RTA, Amritsar is directed to show cause** in writing or through affidavit under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act, as to why penalty be not imposed upon him for willful delay/ denial of the information to the RTI applicant and why the compensation be not awarded to the complainant under Section 19 (8)(b) of the Act for detriment suffered.

In addition to his submission, the PIO is also hereby given an opportunity under Section 20(1) proviso, thereto, for a personal hearing before the imposition of such penalty on the next date of hearing. He may note that in case he does not file his submission and does not avail himself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the next date fixed, it will be presumed that he has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceedings against him ex-parte.

6. Respondent PIO is directed to deal this case on priority and supply the information immediately after receipt of this order, without further delay.
7. The appellant is also advised to point out deficiencies within 7 days from the receipt of information, failing which the case shall be decided on merits.
8. With the aforesaid directions, **the matter is adjourned for further hearing on 28.06.2023 at 11:00 A.M. at 11:00 A.M. at Punjab State Information Commission.** Copy of the order be sent to the parties.
