ORDER:

- The RTI application is dated 01.02.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. - 2. The case has been heard today in the Commission's office at Chandigarh. Shri Sat Paul Sharma, Appellant states that he is not satisfied with the information supplied. He further mentions his letter dated 22.09.2022 which has been sent to the bench, which is taken on record.
- 3. On the asking of this bench, Shri Rajeev Saggar, Superintendent states that the information has been supplied to the Appellant vide letter dated 18.10.2022 and further clarifies that the comments which they have received from the concerned department have been passed on to the Appellant. He further mentions about the letter number 4875 dated 18.10.2022 which has been handed over to the appellant outside before entering the court today. He also mentions about a letter vide endorsement number 4876-77 dated 18.10.2022 which has been sent to the bench and is taken on record.
- 4. Shri Sat Paul Sharma, appellant shows his dissatisfaction to the same.
- 5. After going through the RTI application and the reply filed by the department, as also submissions made; the bench observes that satisfactory reply has been given by the department to the appellant and no further cause for intervention is left in this case.
