## ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 20.10.2022 vide which the case was adjourned for 21.11.2022. But the case could not be heard on the said date and further adjourned for today.

2. The appellant has sought the following information as per his RTI application:-

1. Please give the full details of the SPIOs, including their names, departments, year and amount etc., penalized by SIC.
2. Out of these SPIOs who had been penalized by SIC, please give the details of SPIOs who have deposited the amount and details of those who have not deposited the amount.
3. Details of the action taken, correspondence made by the office of SIC in connection with these SPIOs, who have not paid, deposited the penalized amount yet.

3. The appellant is absent without intimation although a notice of hearing was sent to the appellant through registered post. However, the respondent-Public Information Officer submits that the appellant has already inspected the record pertaining to the sought information on 7.11.2022. He further submits that after the inspection by the appellant, no submissions have been received from him.

4. Since, the appellant has not made any submissions and he has already inspected the record, therefore, the Commission is of the view that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed. However, the appellant is at liberty to approach the Commission within two weeks in case he has any submission to make for the consideration.
