ORDER:

1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 02.11.2022 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.
2. The case has been heard today. Shri Anil Sharma, appellant has not come present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench or through cisco webex.
3. Shri Raj Kumar Bansal, Administrative Officer/PIO, PUDA, Mohali comes present to attend the hearing through cisco webex and states that RTI application was transferred to GMADA vide letter dated 12.10.2022.
4. The Bench observes that during the previous hearing, Shri Shaminder Singh from GMADA had come present who had informed that information on point No.1 & 2 has been supplied to the appellant vide letter dated 27.10.2022 and points No.3 & 4 relate to Policy Branch of PUDA, to whom the RTI application has been transferred. Accordingly, the PIO, Policy Branch of PUDA was directed to supply information on point No.3 & 4. On the asking of the Bench, Shri Raj Kumar Bansal, PIO states that the information on point No.3 & 4 has been supplied to the appellant by S.E. (C-1), GMADA, Mohali vide letter dated 29.11.2022 on his WhatsApp number and by e.mail to Hon'ble Commission.

4. The appellant Shri Anil Sharma is contacted on his mobile phone. He does not respond even after repeated attempts made to contact him.

5. The Bench observes that the appellant has absented himself for the second consecutive hearing and he also does not respond to the phone calls and as such, the Bench presumes that the appellant has received information to his satisfaction and does not want to pursue the matter further.

6. In view of the above, the Bench is not inclined to proceed further in the matter. **The instant appeal case is disposed off and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
