

ORDER:

- 1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 01.11.2022 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.
- 2. The case has been heard today. The appellant Shri Amritpal Singh comes present in person before the Bench and states that he has received incomplete information as the information on point No.1 has not been provided.
- 3. Shri Ramninder Singh, Senior Assistant, Local Govt.-1 Branch, Local Govt. Department, Punjab, comes present to attend the hearing on behalf of the PIO/Respondent in person before the Bench and states that the information has been sent to the appellant vide letter dated 01.12.2022 by registered post. He also produces before the Bench copy of the same. He also apprises the Bench that the amount of penalty of Rs.5000/- has been deposited in the Govt. Treasury and produces copy of challan.
- 4. The appellant contends that the information does not include information on point No.1. Then the respondent clarifies that information supplied includes about 25 pages of notings and covers the information on both the points as both the letters of appellant have been dealt with in the same file.

5. The Bench takes on record the evidence for having deposited the amount of penalty and is

also convinced that adequate information stands supplied. However, since the appellant is not satisfied, the

Bench directs the PIO to file an affidavit on e-stamp paper, within 21 (Twenty one) days duly signed by the

PIO and attested by the Notary Public to the effect that the information as available in the official records in

AC No.4412/2021 has been supplied to the appellant. It be further stated that nothing has been concealed

therein and the statement made is true and correct. Original affidavit be sent to the appellant and copy of the

same be sent to the Commission for record.

6. With the aforesaid directions, the instant appeal case is disposed off and closed. Copies

of the order be sent to the concerned parties.
