## **ORDER**

- 1. The RTI application is dated 14.03.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 09.05.2022 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 23.09.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for hearing through CISCO WEBEX on 03.01.2023 i.e. today.
- 2. In today's hearing both the parties are present.
- 3. Respondent, Dr. Jasdeep Kaur states that a similar case (AC: 2125 of 2022) was disposed of and closed by the undersigned Bench on 09.08.2022. She adds that reply has already been supplied to the appellant on 06.06.2022.
- 4. On this, appellant states that the RTI application in the present case was filed to the Government instead of Board. He adds that he want a reply from the Government.
