**ORDER:**

1. This order may be read with reference to the order dated 09.11.2022 passed by this Bench on the previous hearing.
2. The case has been heard today. Shri Mandeep Singh, appellant comes present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench and reiterates his version as made during the previous hearing.
3. Smt. Tarsem Kaur, Superintendent, Establishment/PIO and Shri Gurprinder Singh, Senior Assistant, O/o Director, Local Govt., Punjab come present in person before the Bench. The respondent Shri Gurprinder Singh states that the information was denied to the appellant under Section 8(1)(j), being personal and third party information. He also makes reference to Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment in this regard and reads out its relevant contents before the Bench.
4. On the asking of the Bench, the respondent explains the details of information asked for by the appellant. On hearing the version of respondent, the Bench does not accept the contention raised by the PIO and as such, directs to provide information to the appellant. Accordingly, the respondent states that he has brought along the same and hands over copy of the same to the appellant in the court itself and also produces before the Bench copy of letters provided to the appellant.
5. The appellant, on perusal of the same, expresses satisfaction over the information supplied and also gives his consent to close the case.
6. In view of the above, no further cause of action is left in the matter. **The instant appeal case is disposed off and closed.** Copies of the order be sent to the parties.
