## ORDER

The RTI application is dated 22.2.2021 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter called FAA) on 21.6.2022 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 29.9.2022 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter called RTI Act). Notice of hearing was issued to the parties for 22.11.2022. But the case could not be heard on the said date and further adjourned for today.

2. The appellant has sought the information related to his complaint dated 3.5.2018.

3. The appellant is absent without intimation. However, the representative of the respondents submits that the information as available on record comprising 75 pages has already been supplied to the appellant vide letter dated 20.5.2022. He has also filed the specific reply in this regard, which is taken on record. He further submits that nothing more is available on record which could be supplied to the appellant as per his RTI application and requested to close the case.

4. Keeping in view the submissions made by the respondent and no deficiency has been received from the appellant, therefore, the Commission is of the view that no further action is required to be taken in this case. Hence, the case is disposed of and closed.
