Present: i) Shri Amarjit Singh Dhamotia along with Shri Gurmej Lal, representative of the appellant through cisco webex.

ii) None is present from the Respondent / PIO. **ORDER:** 

1. The RTI application is dated 07.10.2022 vide which the appellant has sought information

as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 08.11.2022 and the second appeal was filed in the Commission on 06.01.2023 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act).

The case has been heard today. Shri Gurmej Lal attends the hearing on behalf of the 2. appellant through cisco webex and states that no information has been supplied to the Appellant so far.

3. Neither the PIO has come present to attend the hearing in person before the Bench nor through cisco webex nor he has deputed any of his representatives to attend the hearing on behalf of the PIO.

4. Commission takes a serious view of the casual approach of the Respondent / PIO, as no information has been supplied to the appellant and today nobody appears from the department to represent this case.

In view of the foregoing, respondent PIO, O/o Principal Secretary, Local Govt., 5. Punjab, Chandigarh is directed to Show Cause in writing or through affidavit under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act, as to why penalty should not be imposed upon him for wilful delay / denial of the information to the RTI applicant and why the compensation be not awarded to the appellant under Section 19 (8)(b) of the Act for detriment suffered.

6. In addition to his submission, the PIO is also hereby given an opportunity under Section 20(1) proviso, thereto, for a personal hearing before the imposition of such penalty on the next date of hearing. He may note that in case he does not file his submission and does not avail himself of the opportunity of personal hearing on the next date fixed, it will be presumed that he has nothing to say and the Commission shall proceed to take further proceedings against him ex-parte.
