ORDER:

1. The Appellant filed above mentioned appeal case in the Commission. Accordingly, the case is fixed for today.
2. Appellant is absent without any intimation to the Commission.
3. Respondent, Smt. Anita Rani stated that the reply received from the Establishment office (P&R), Markfed H.O. vide No.FED/P&R/2022/5076 dated 6.6.2022 was supplied to the appellant vide No.PIO/RTI/2022/240 dated 13.6.2022 reply received from Estt. Officer(Ing) Markfed H.O. vide No.EOI/EAI-2/23/2022/4150 date 24.8.2022 was supplied to the appellant vide No. PIO/2022/418 dated 25.8.2022 and reply received from Public Information officer, Markfed Sangrur vide No. DMS/2022/10910 dated 27.2.2023 was supplied to appellant vide No.PIO/RTI/2023/223 dated 2.3.2023. She further added that if the appellant still feels not satisfies he can visit office for record inspection on any working day.
4. Keeping in view the facts of the case and the submissions made by the PIO, the Commission observes that an appropriate response as per the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005 has been provided by the Respondent hence no further intervention of the Commission is required in the matter. However, in the interest of justice, Commission provides the liberty to the appellant to inspect record. The PIO is directed to offer inspection of the relevant available records to the appellant at a mutually convenient date and time, within 15 days from the date of receipt of this order. The appellant is directed to avail of the said offer within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of the letter of inspection from the respondent authority, failing which no further opportunity will be provided to him. A Compliance report shall be submitted by the Respondent before the Commission within 45 from issue of this order without fail. The appeal is disposed of accordingly.
